

# CAHPS Intersections

Intercession courses are a fun way for us to offer electives to CAHPS students. Each trimester, students will meet in their Intercession course four times. The first three times they will meet for one hour, and the fourth time they'll meet for the whole day. Intercession courses range from PE credits, elective credits, science credits, career/technical credits, to service learning credits. Students who successfully complete their intercession will earn 1/3 of a credit. If a student completed three of the same type of intercession, they would combine into a full credit.
